

## What is the course about?

This course follows on from Next Steps in Novel Writing and looks at the latter stage of a big writing project – how to end your novel and what to do next.

## Why should I choose the course?

This course is for anybody who wants to write a novel and would like motivation and encouragement from like-minded people.

## What will I learn?

This course follows the same structure as our next steps course, with the class split in half and one half of the group devoted to the class topic (with a writing exercise to get you warmed up) and the second half devoted to your own novel work. You will be allocated independent writing time, and you will discuss your progress with classmates who will be able to offer feedback on your work. Topics we will cover will include:

- The Third Act
- Writing the ending that is right for your novel
- Editing your work
- Writing query letters and synopses
- Publishing (including self-publishing)
