

## What is the course about?

This ESOL course is designed to help you develop the speaking and listening proficiencies needed for the B1–B2 level English Language Tests (SELT - Secure English Language Tests). These tests are needed for naturalisation or visa purposes.

By the end of the course, you will be able to use English confidently at B1–B2 level. You will have gained the skills needed to succeed in formal speaking and listening tests. These include giving clear answers, expressing your ideas, and responding appropriately. You will also be well prepared to handle real-life communication tasks, using the same skills you practice for your test.

## Why should I choose the course?

You should choose this ESOL course because it will:

- Help you prepare for SELT (Secure English Language Test) speaking exams.
- Build your confidence in speaking English in real situations.
- Use practical, everyday topics that are useful outside the classroom.
- Support you step-by-step from guided practice to independent speaking.

On this B1-B2 preparation ESOL course, you will learn to:

- Talk about your life, work, and experiences.

Improve your:

- Pronunciation.
- Listening skills.
- Confidence and fluency.



You will also develop exam skills such as:

- Extending your answers.
- Speaking for longer (long turns).
- Managing hesitation naturally.

After completing this course, you can:

- Take a SELT speaking & listening exam independently.
- Progress to higher-level ESOL courses (Level 1–Level 2).
