You will also practice real-life situations, such as going shopping, making appointments, and filling in forms.

After completing this ESOL course, you may want to progress to accredited ESOL Entry Level qualifications at the college.

You'll also have improved confidence to use English independently in daily life and work, and better opportunities in employment and further education.
