Bring your creative ideas to life with this exciting and imaginative short course. It is suitable for beginners or for learners who have completed the Basics and Design & Concepts courses.

What will I learn?

Each week, you will learn new floristry techniques using seasonal flowers, including:

- Creating various classic designs, such as round and long displays
- Developing techniques to produce oasis-free arrangements, for example jug and vase displays
- · Gaining expertise in the use of colour in arrangements, including colour blending, contrasting, and monochrome
- · Practising sustainability through upcycling and reducing the use of containers and materials
- · Building a record of your work that can be used for employment, volunteering, or further development

You will be informally assessed by your tutor and will also self-assess your weekly progress using an individual learning plan.

What will the course lead on to?

After completing this course, you may wish to progress onto other short floristry courses offered throughout the year, such as themed courses including wedding and Christmas floristry.
