Are there any additional costs associated with the course?

Students are required to bring their own floristry or household scissors each week, along with a small amount of evergreen greenery. You'll also need to provide your own vessels during the course—these can be items you already have at home or ones you pick up from charity shops.

If you are sensitive to handling flowers or foliage, we recommend wearing gardening or rubber gloves for comfort and protection.
