What is the course about?

The NCFE CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Understanding Specific Learning Difficulties is designed to provide you with a comprehensive understanding of Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD)/Attention Deficit Disorder (ADD), Dyslexia, Developmental Coordination Disorder and Dyscalculia.

The course will cover the diagnosis and how to support individuals with these learning difficulties in various environments. It is suitable for anyone working or looking to work with individuals with specific learning difficulties in education, health and social care.

Choosing this course will help you develop a deep understanding of specific learning difficulties, which is increasingly relevant in education.

What will I learn?

The course is made up of five units:

- ? Understanding supporting individuals with specific learning difficulties
- ? Understand the context of specific learning difficulties

The course is delivered online through Google Classroom by a subject specialist tutor.

The qualification is internally assessed using a range of methods including written assignments or tasks.
