What is the course about?

This Level 3 qualification is a one-year course, equivalent to three A Levels, specifically designed for adults aged 19 and above. It provides the essential foundation to progress to university and pursue a career in policing or criminology fields.

The Access to Higher Education Diploma in Criminal Justice is tailored for those without traditional qualifications who are aiming to study a related degree at university and pursue a rewarding career in this sector.

This course not only helps refresh your study skills but also builds your confidence, empowering you to succeed in a higher education environment and take the next step toward your academic and professional goals.

Why should I choose the course?

Are you looking to progress on to a job within policing or criminology? This course is designed to enable you to gain the knowledge, skills, and behaviours to progress on to university to study in a number of fields such as sociology, criminology, and forensic science.

Our Level 3 Diploma Access to HE: Criminal Justice course will help you to refresh your study skills and build confidence in your ability to succeed in a learning environment. What are the entry requirements?

Direct Entry Requirements

You will need to hold GCSE English and maths at grade C/4 or above, or equivalent.

However, please be aware that for midwifery, universities often do not allow GCSE equivalencies; it is common for them to only accept English Language and maths at a grade 4/C or above. If you hold equivalent qualifications to GCSE we strongly advise you to check university entry requirements to confirm they will accept your equivalent qualifications.

If you do not meet the entry requirements

 Don't worry - you can apply for our Level 2 Pre-access course which will prepare you for the Level 3 Access to Higher Education course in your chosen pathway. You will also work towards achieving your level 2 (GCSE) maths or English at the same time.

What are my funding options?

19+ students studying on a level 3 qualification may be eligible to apply for an Advanced Learner Loan.
