This course builds on the Introduction to Novel Writing course and takes you deeper into the novel-writing process. You'll explore more advanced techniques, with a particular focus on keeping your story moving and avoiding common challenges such as the 'saggy middle.'

Designed for adult learners aged 19 and over, this part-time course is ideal for anyone who wants to continue working on their novel with added structure and support. You'll write alongside like-minded peers in a friendly, encouraging environment that helps you stay motivated, focused, and confident as you develop your novel.

Why should I choose the course?

If you're serious about writing a novel and want to build on what you've already learned, this course is the ideal next step in your creative journey. It provides the structure, guidance, and motivation needed to keep your project moving, especially through the middle sections of your novel, which many writers find challenging.

You'll benefit from expert input, focused writing exercises, and the opportunity to share your work with others who understand the writing process. The supportive group environment helps you stay accountable, gain fresh perspectives, and remain inspired.

This course is perfect if you're looking for a practical, in-depth experience that will help you stay committed to completing your novel with greater confidence and direction.

What will I learn?

Throughout the course, you will explore a variety of novel-writing topics designed to help you deepen your skills and keep your story moving forward. Each session will be divided into two parts. In the first half, you'll focus on a key writing topic, supported by a short warm-up exercise to get your creativity flowing. The second half of the session will be dedicated to your own novel work, giving you time to write, reflect on your progress, and receive constructive feedback from your peers in a supportive group setting.

Topics covered include:

- Writing the Second Act
- · Staying motivated
- Developing effective side characters
- · Writing authentic dialogue
- · Incorporating romance into your novel
- · Creating and sustaining tension.
