What will I learn?

You will learn the how to upcycle and transform clothing and household/garden items into something new by learning new skills and techniques.

For example:

Embellish clothing using appliques techniques with hand sewing.

Add your own flair and enhance various household items with decoupage using materials and paper.

What will the course lead on to?
